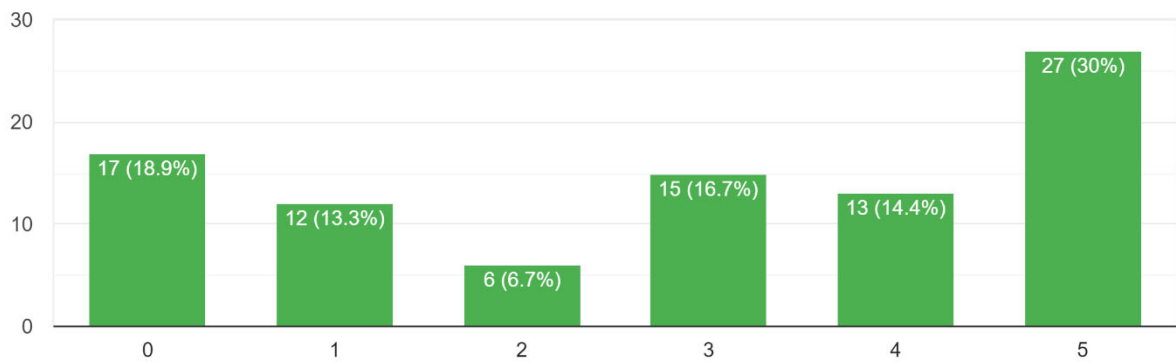


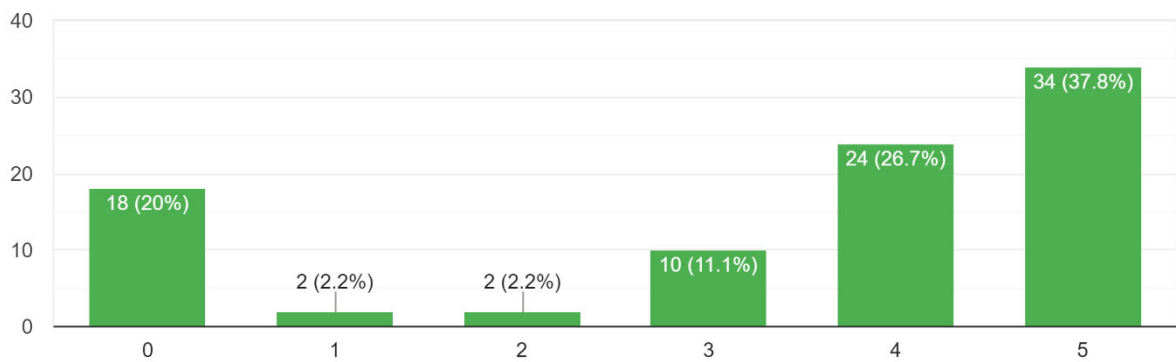
1. Overall quality of law enforcement services from Wise County SO

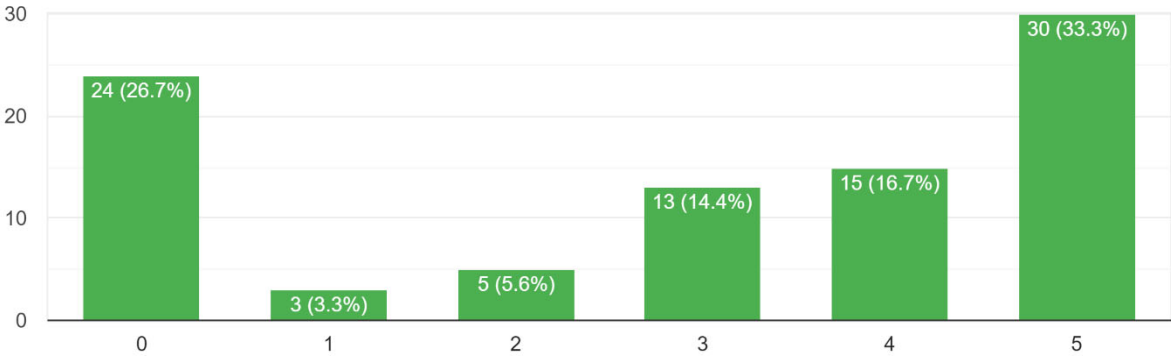
2. Overall quality of fire services from East Wise Fire Rescue or Justin Volunteer FD

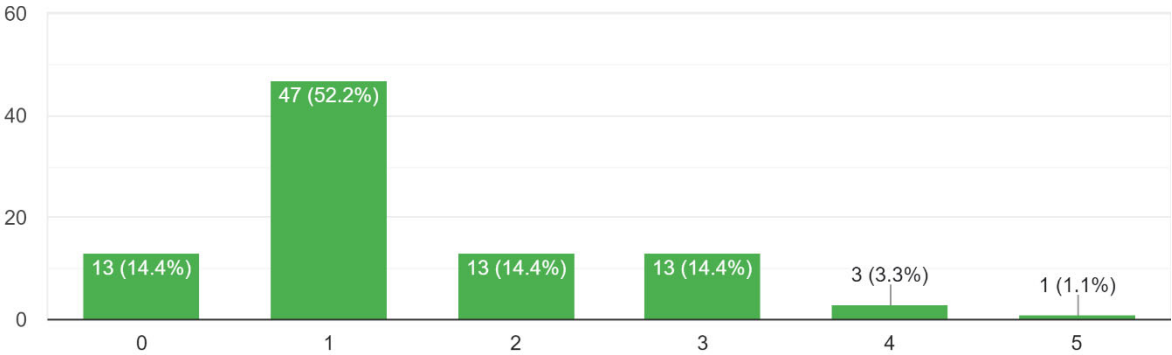
3. Overall quality of medical services from Wise County EMS

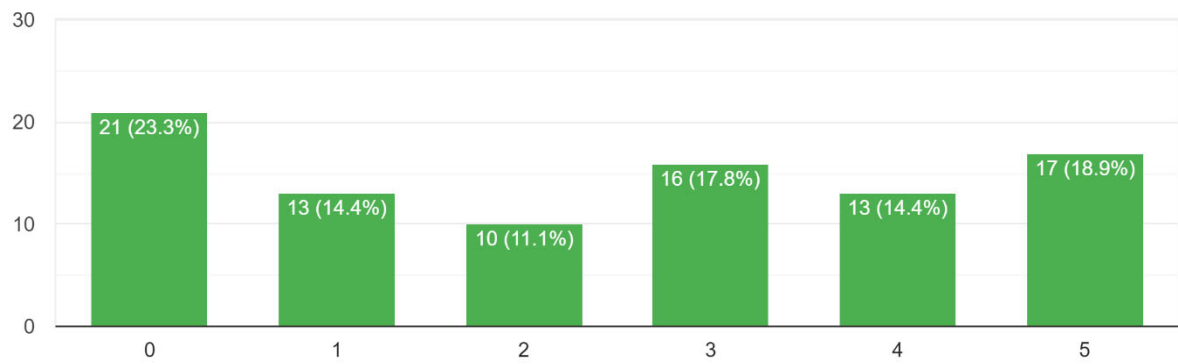
4. Overall maintenance of city streets

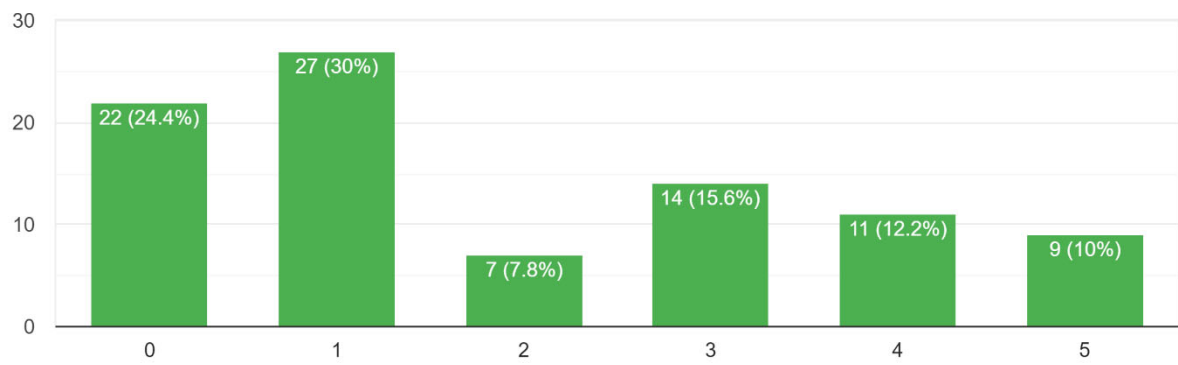

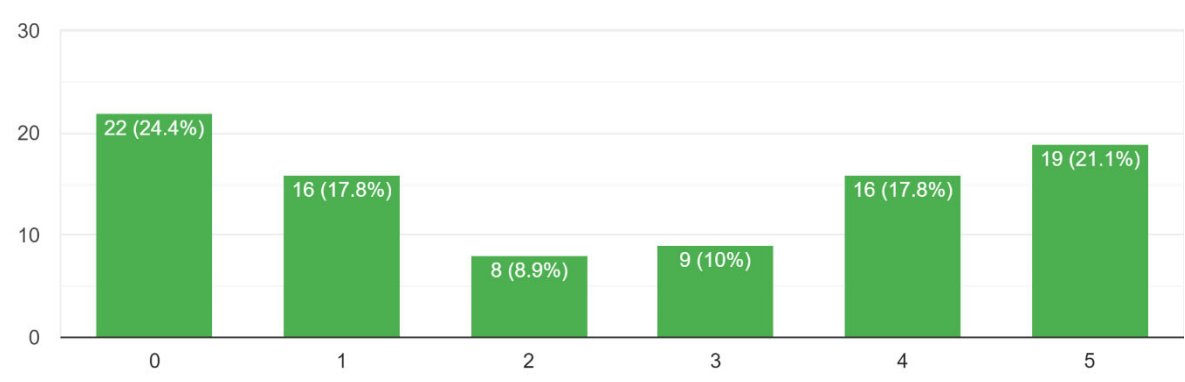

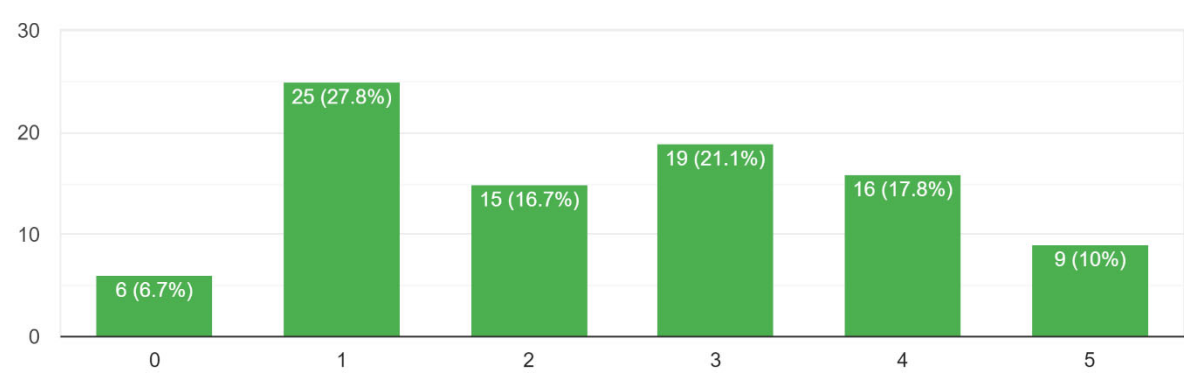
7. Overall quality of customer service you receive from city employees

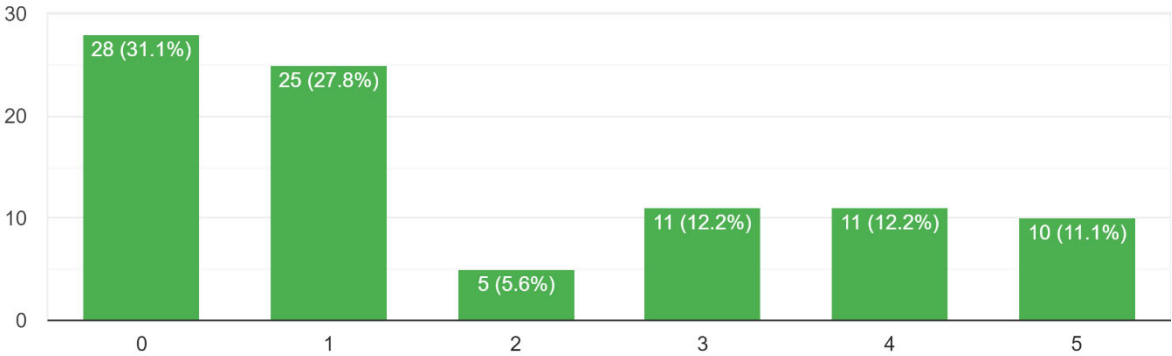
8. Overall effectiveness of city communication with the public

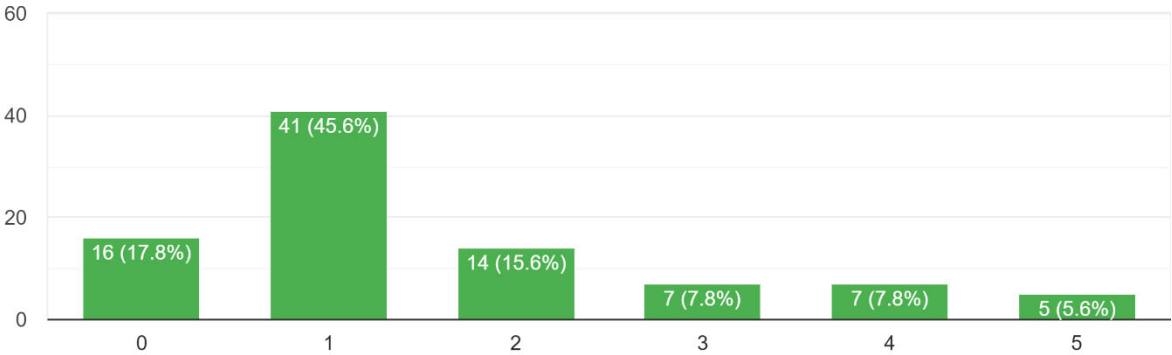
9. Overall quality of the city's storm water runoff/storm water management system

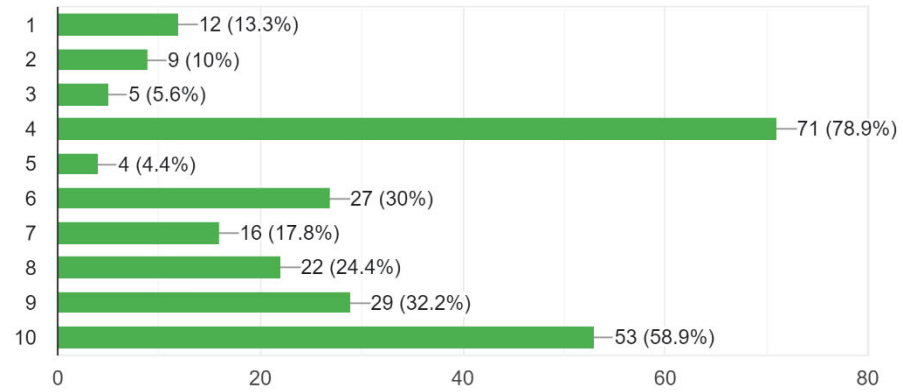

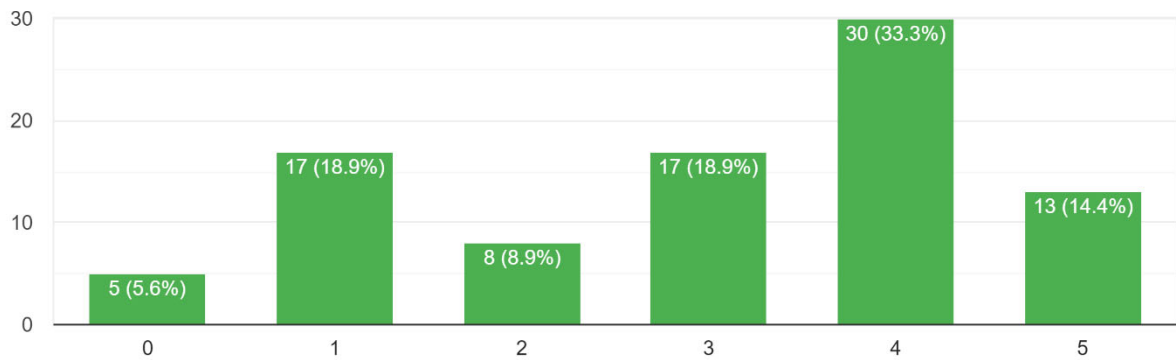

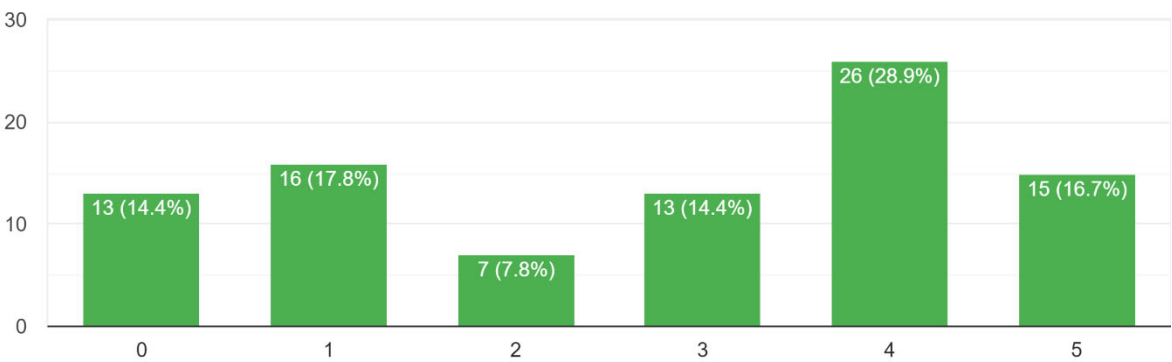

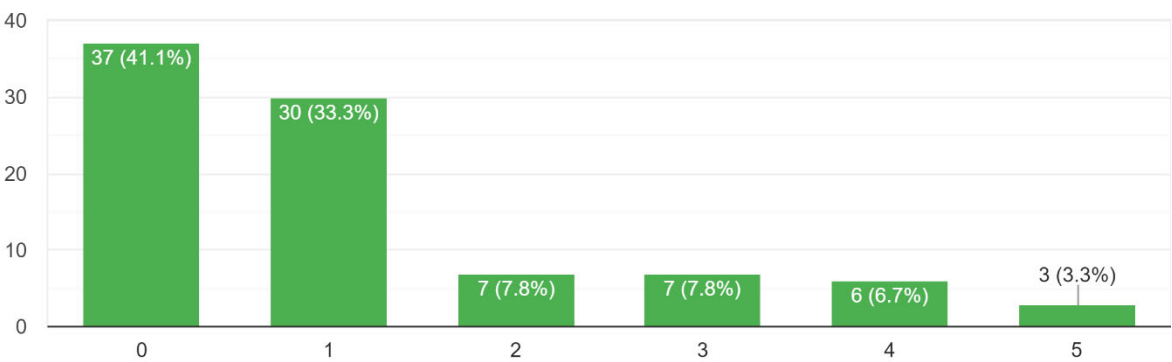

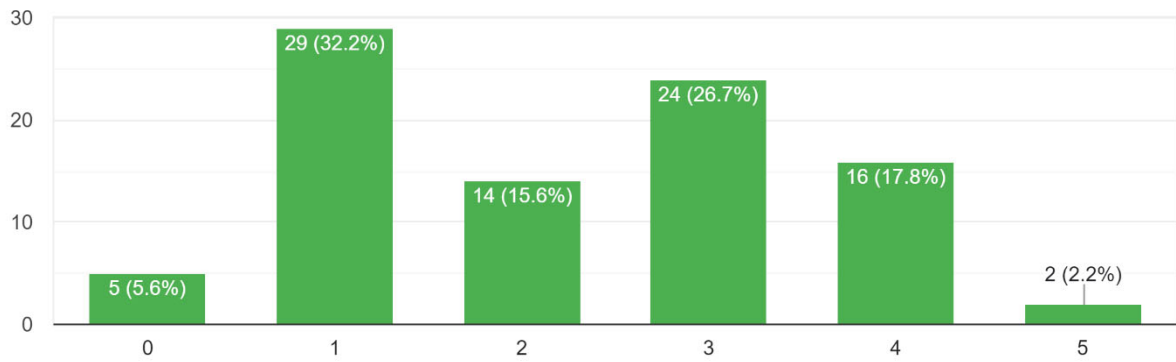

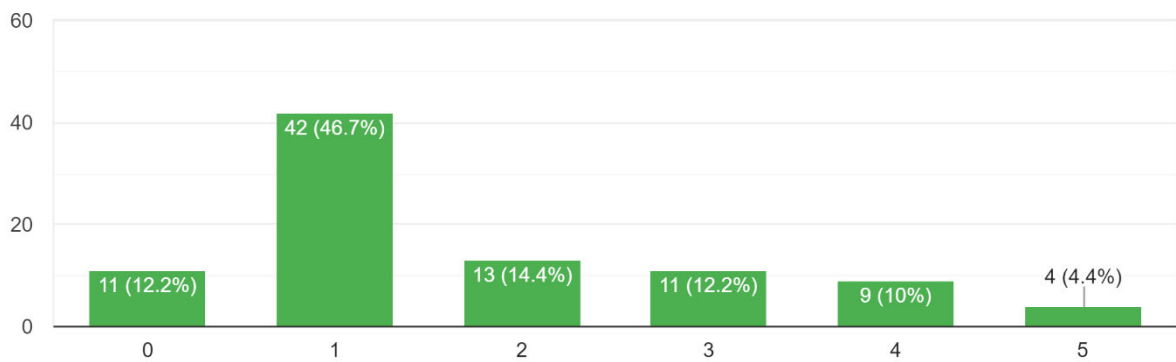

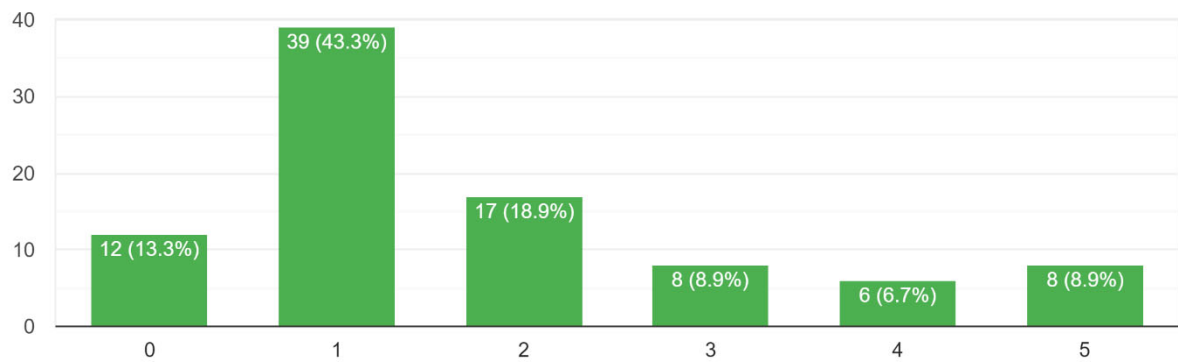

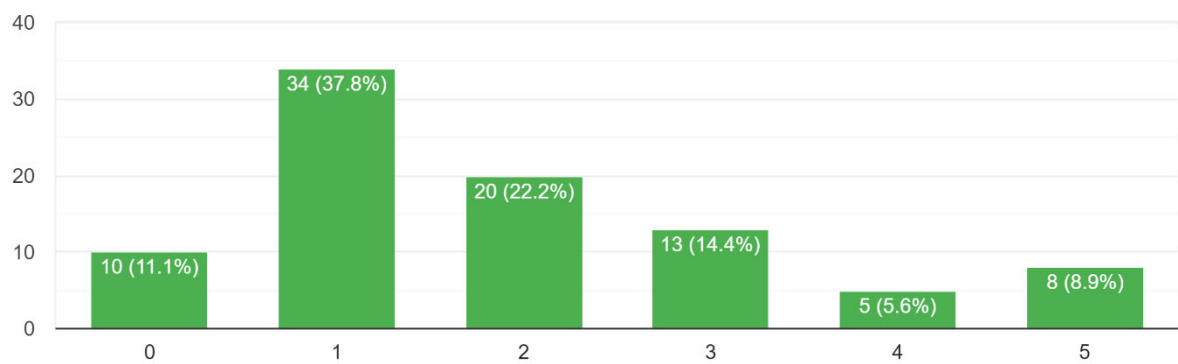
16. Overall trust level in city staff to wisely use city resources

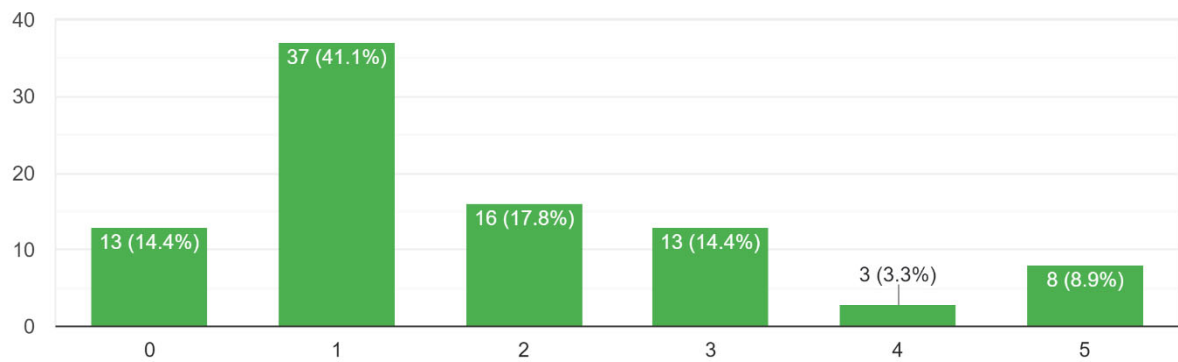

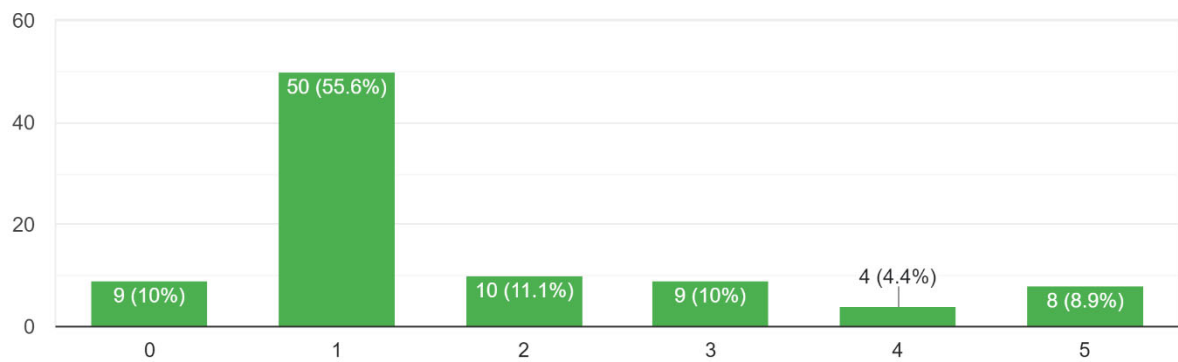

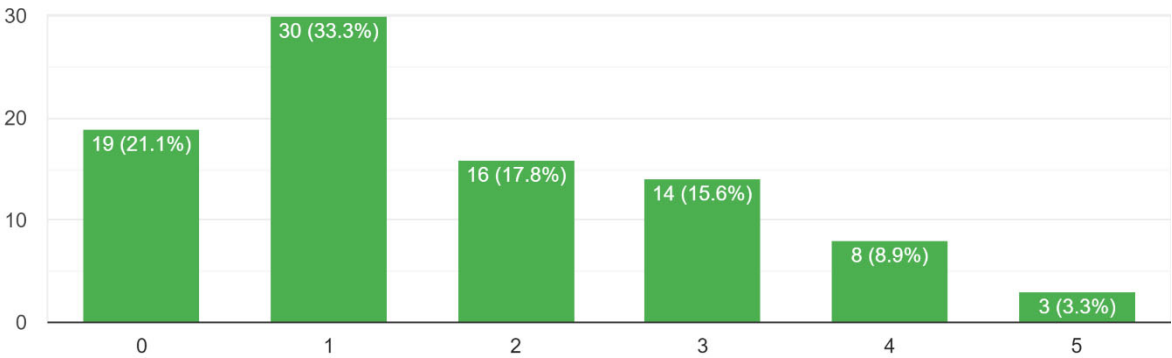
19. Condition of streets in your neighborhood

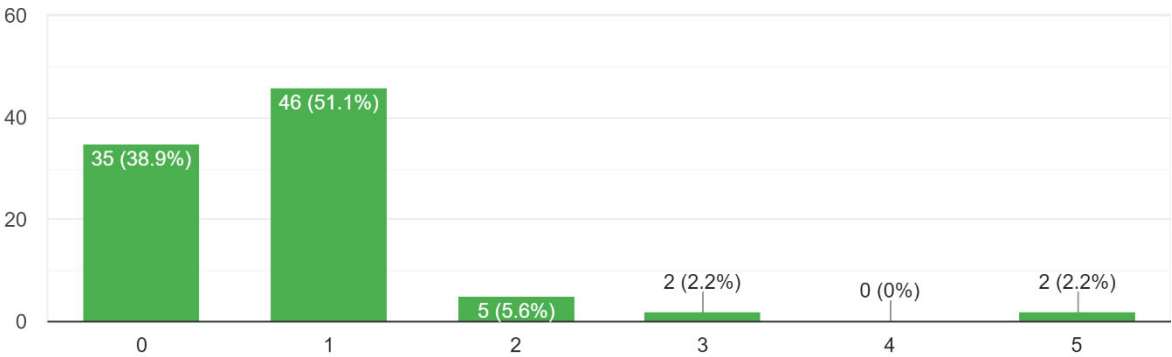
20. Condition of drainage culverts under city streets

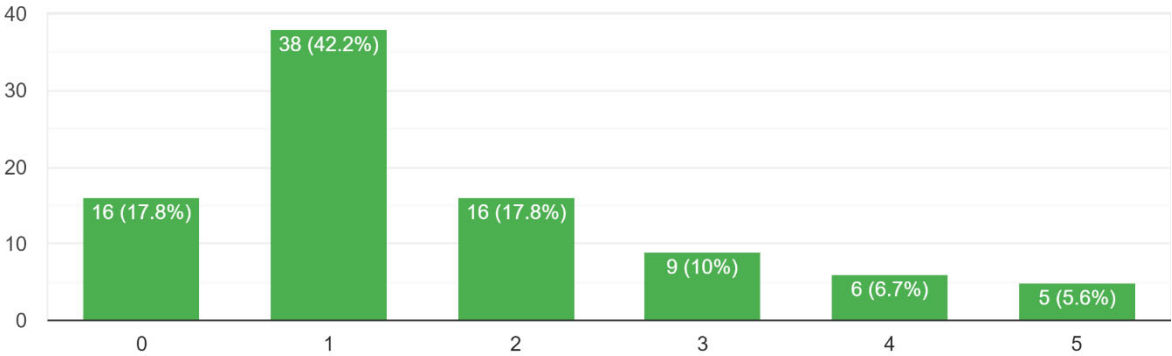

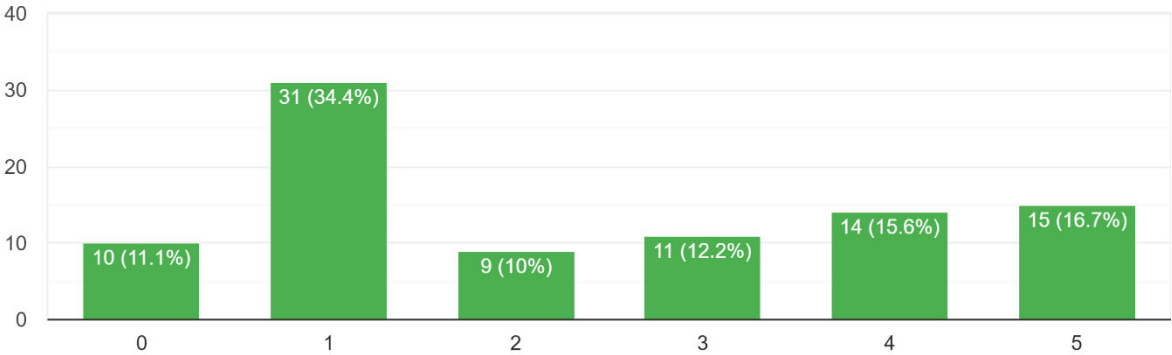

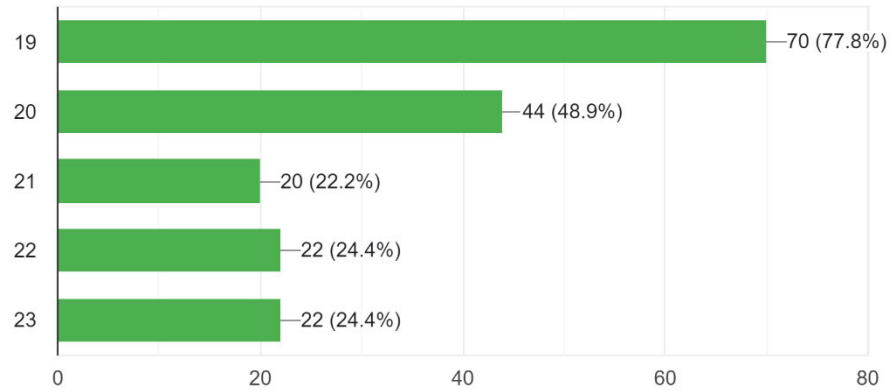
23. Adequacy of the street lighting in your neighborhood

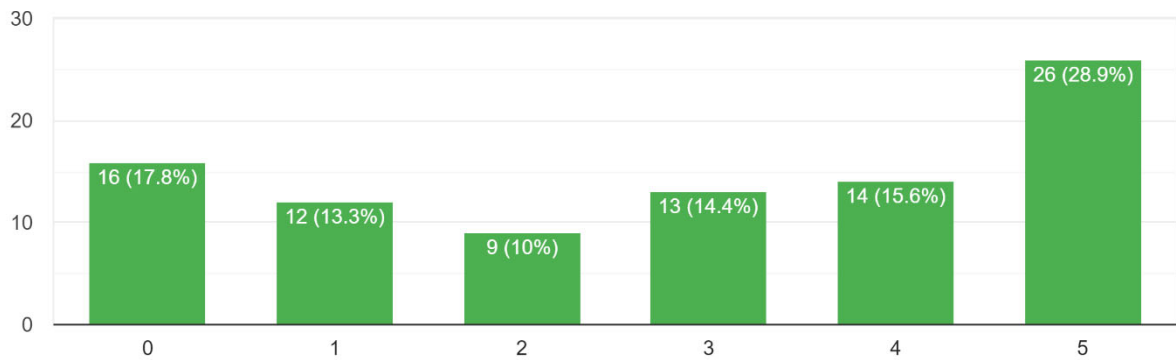

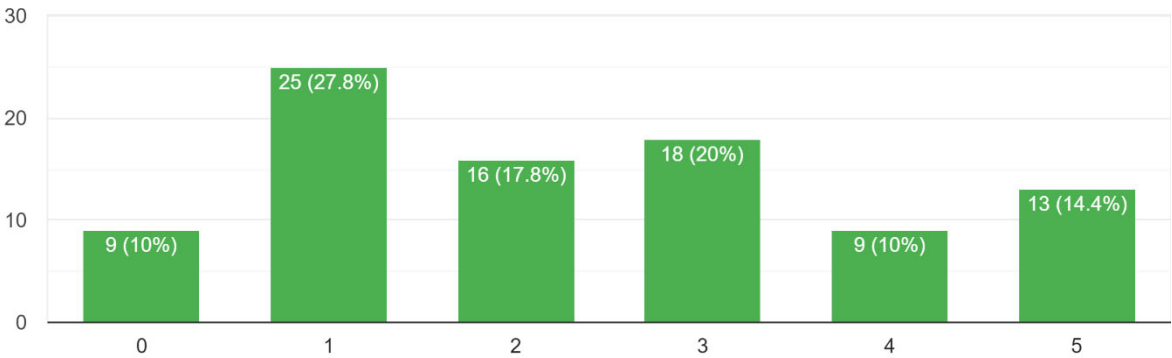
24. Quality of police protection provided by Wise County deputies

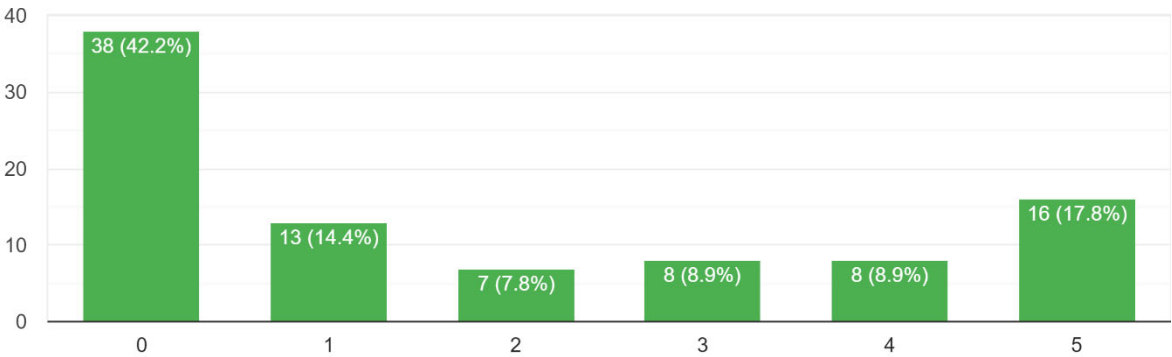
25. Visibility of deputies in neighborhood

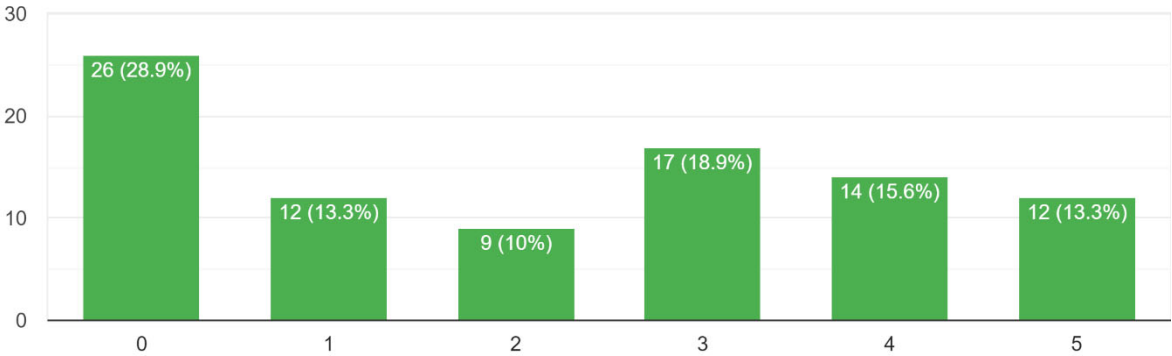

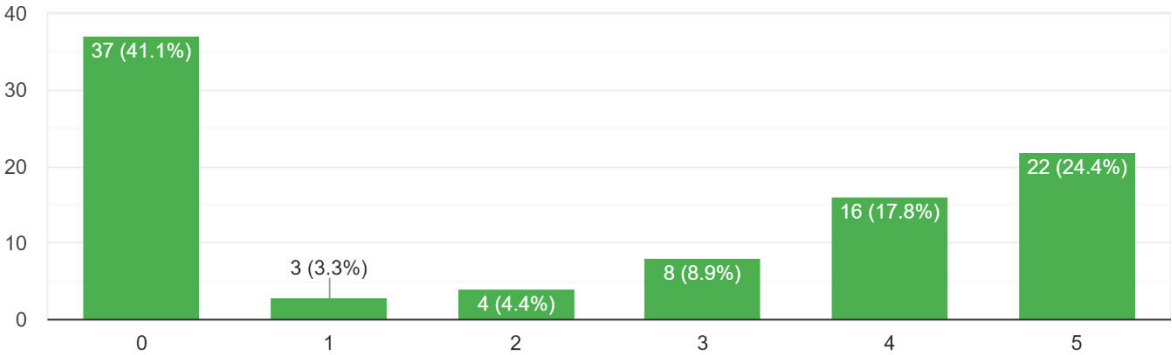
27. Enforcement of traffic laws

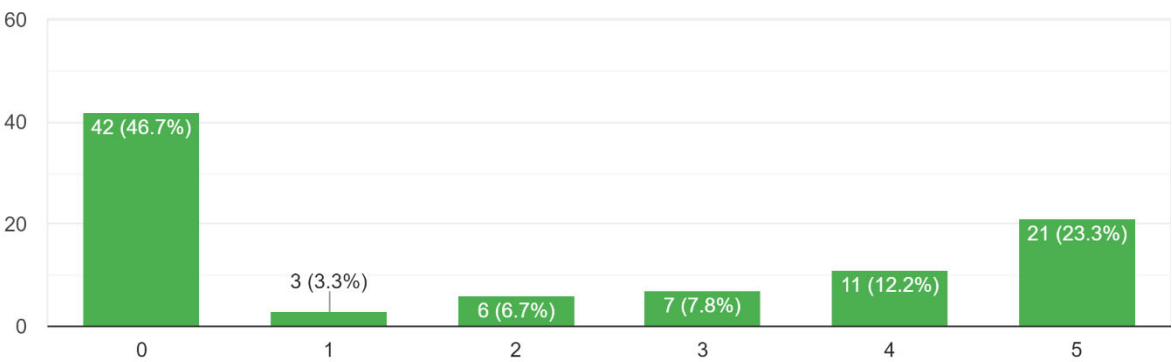
28. Quality of emergency medical services by Wise County EMS

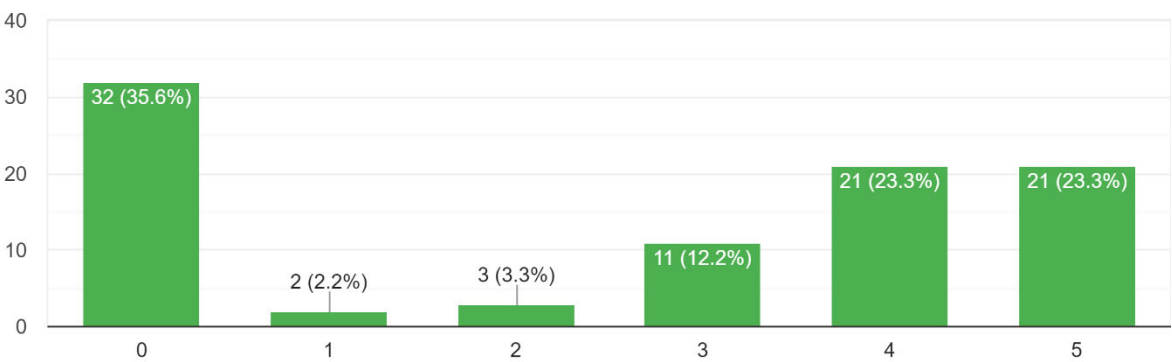

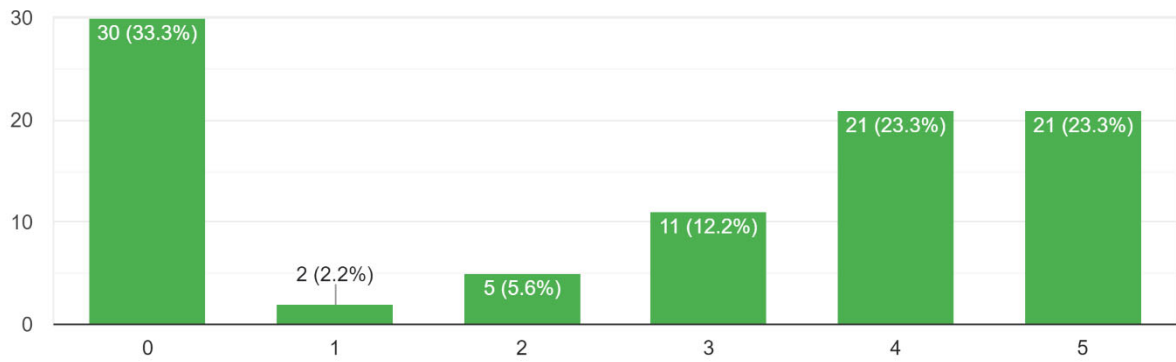
30. Quality of fire protection by East Wise Fire Rescue or Justin Volunteer FD

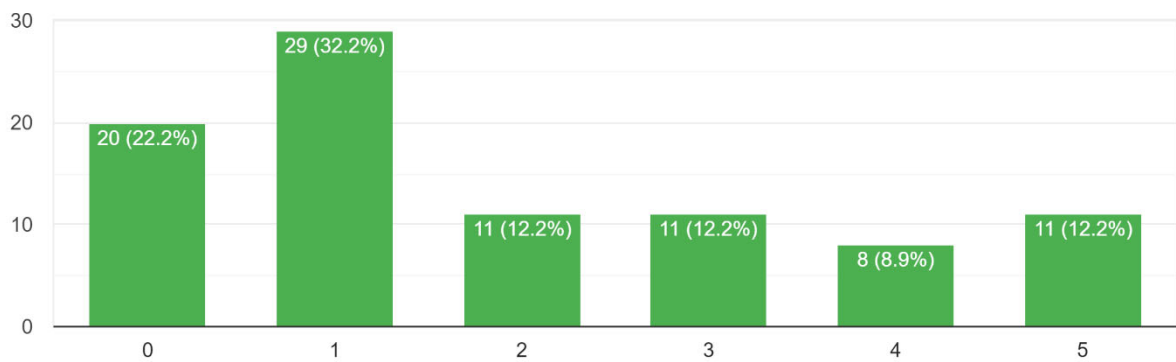

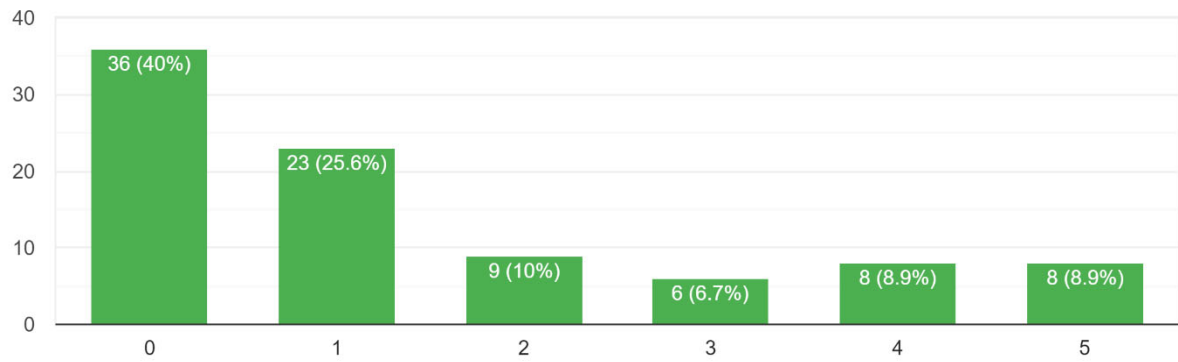
32. Quality of animal control services by Wise County Animal Control Division

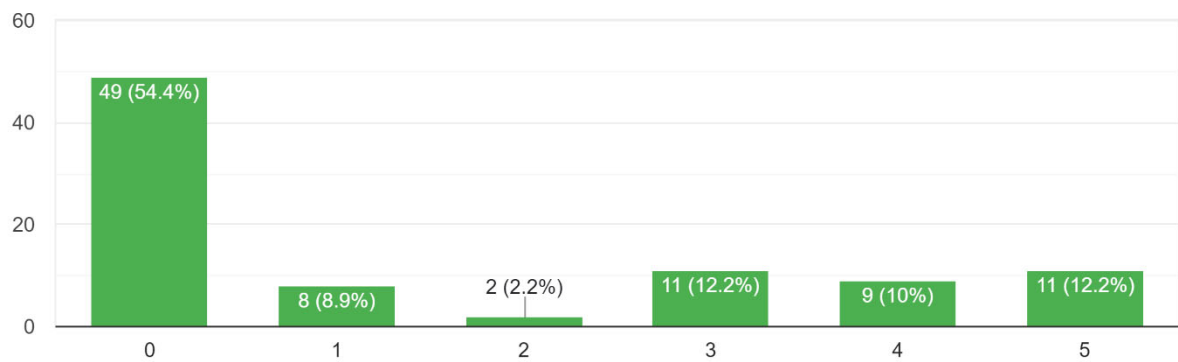

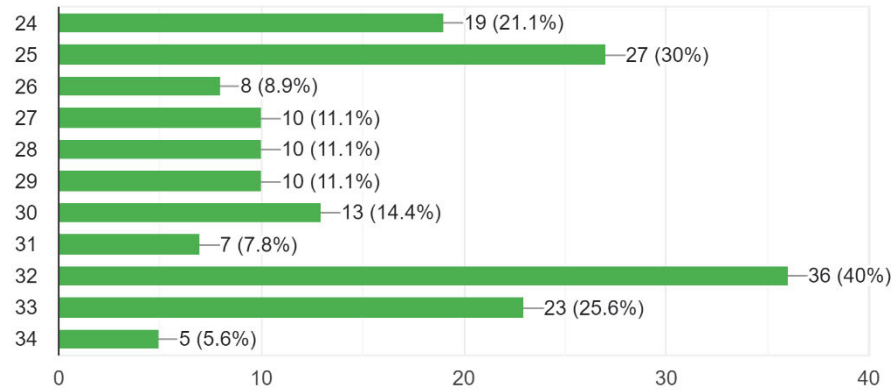

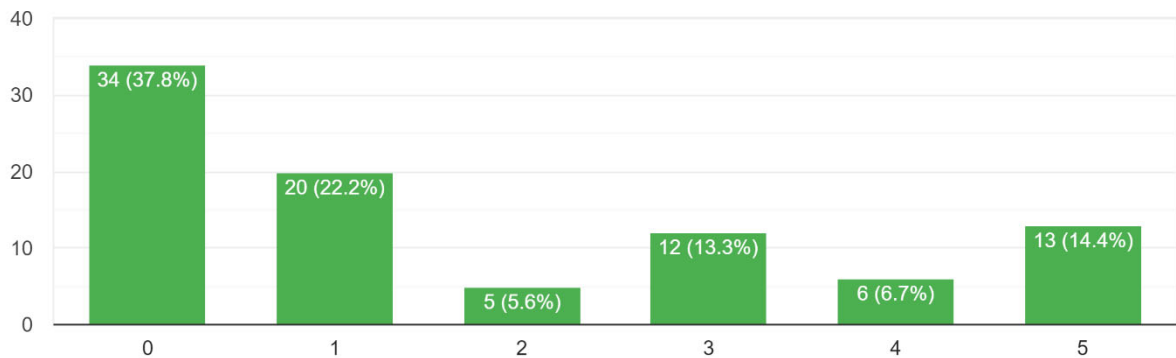

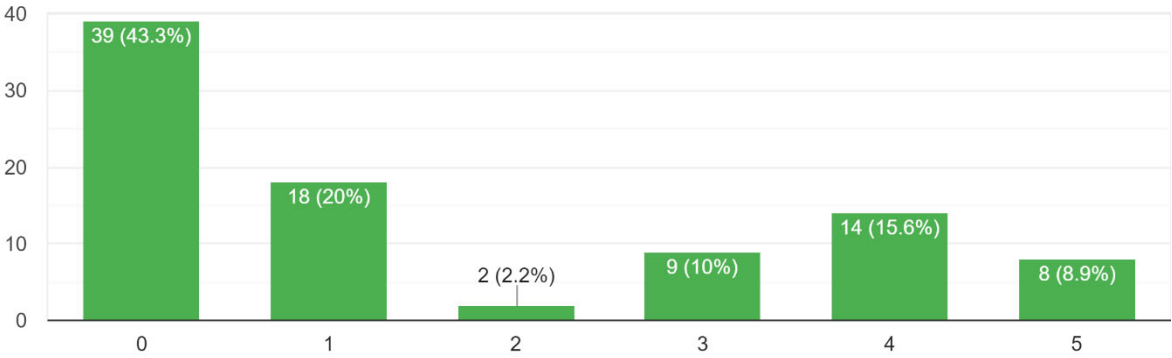

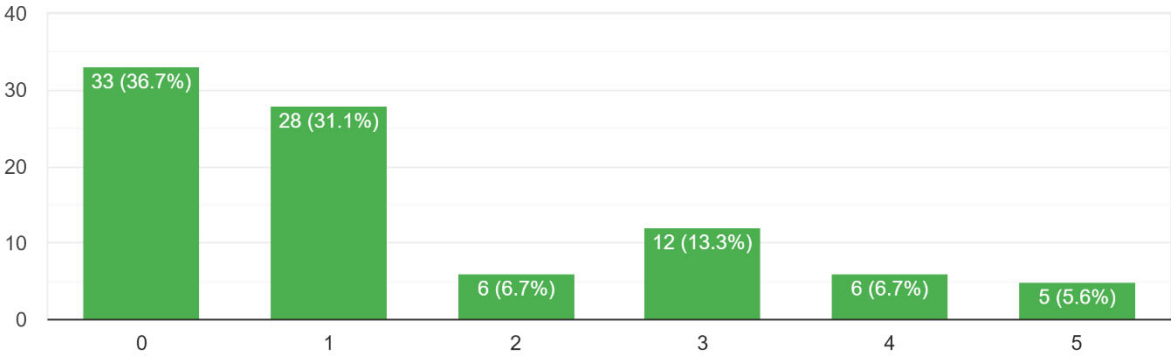

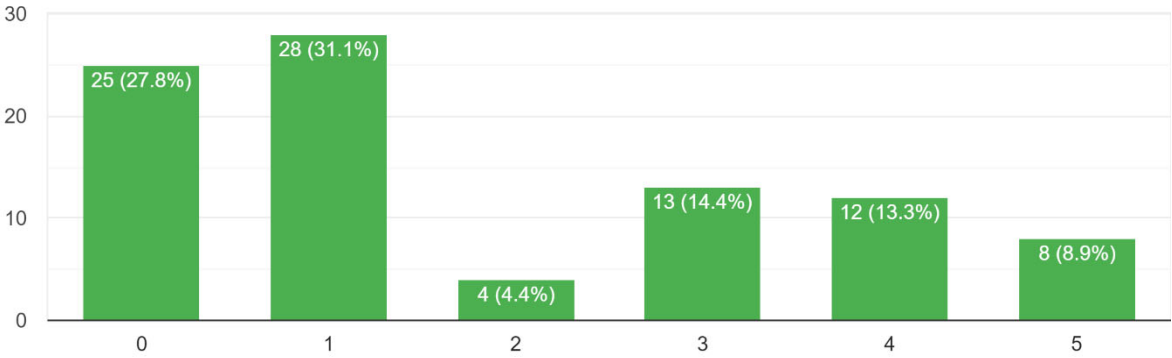

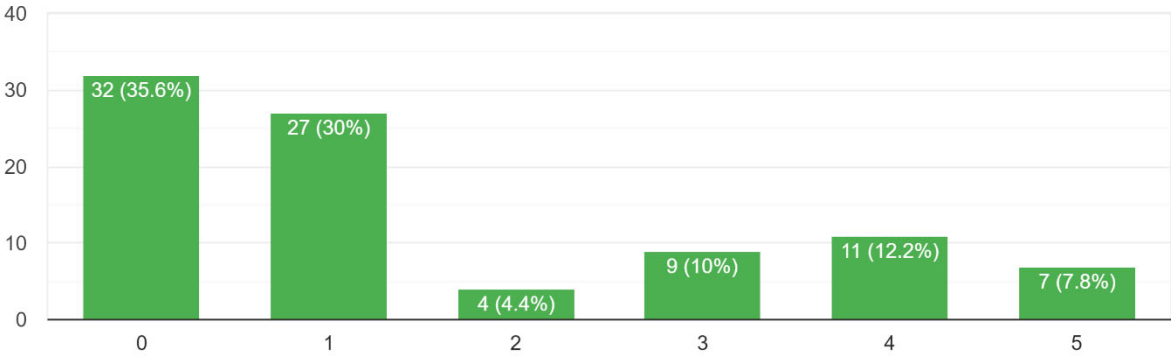

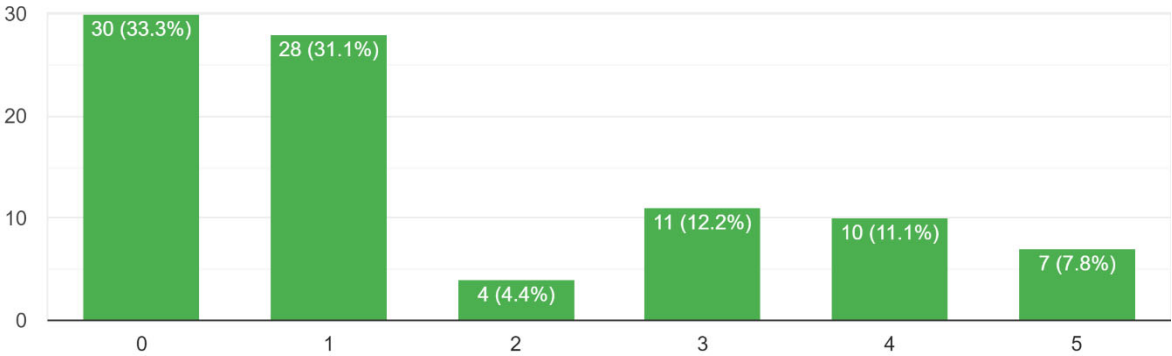

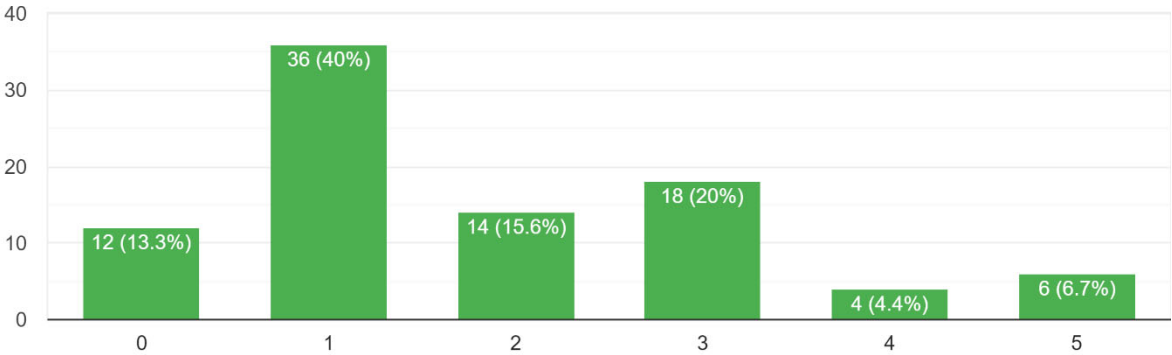

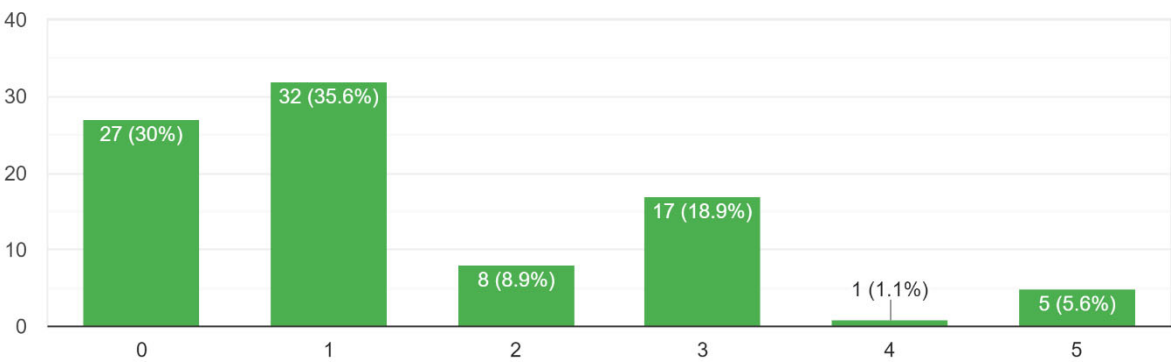

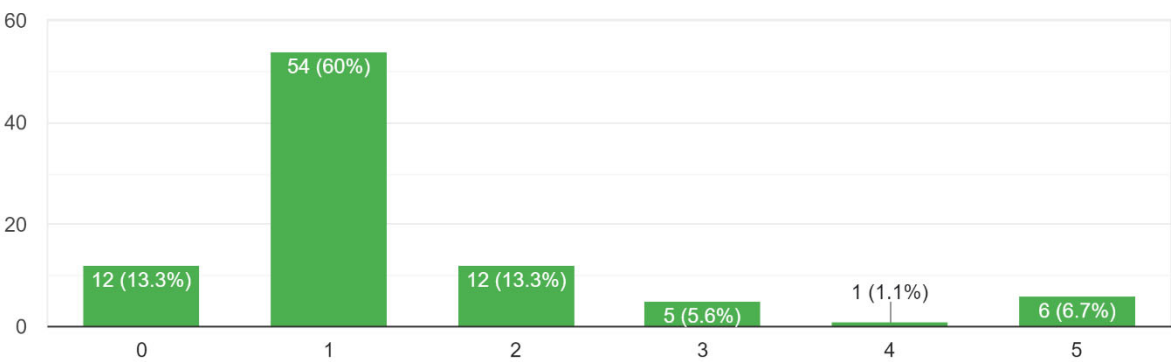

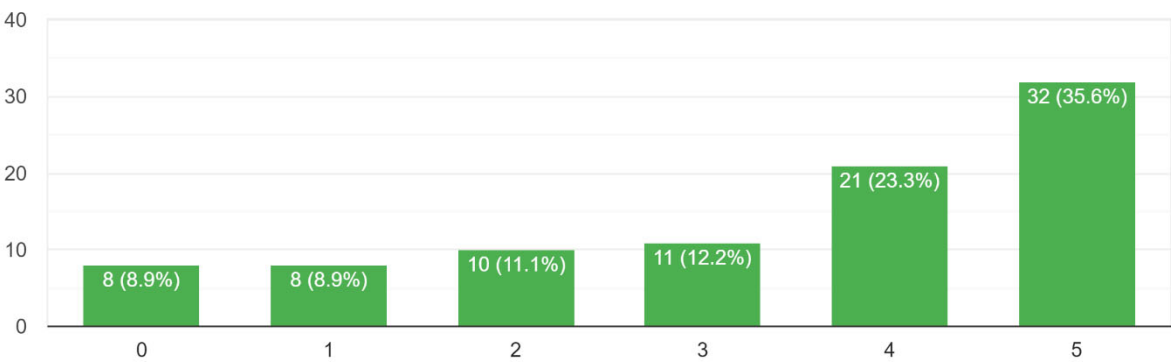

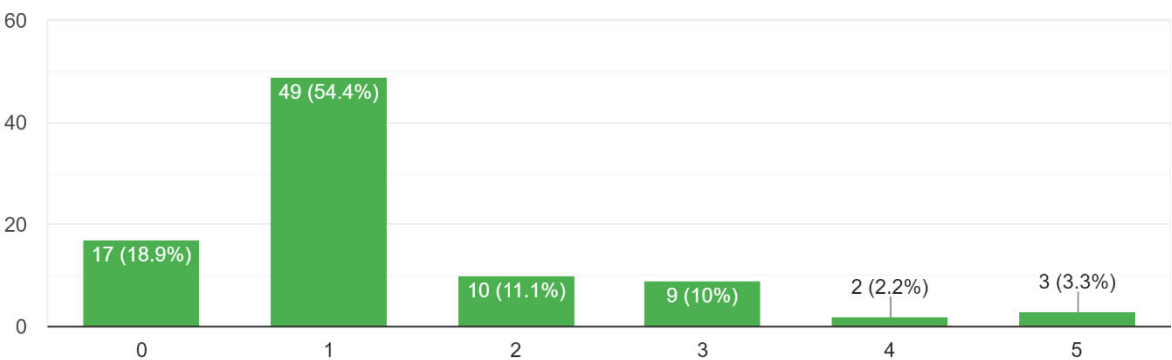

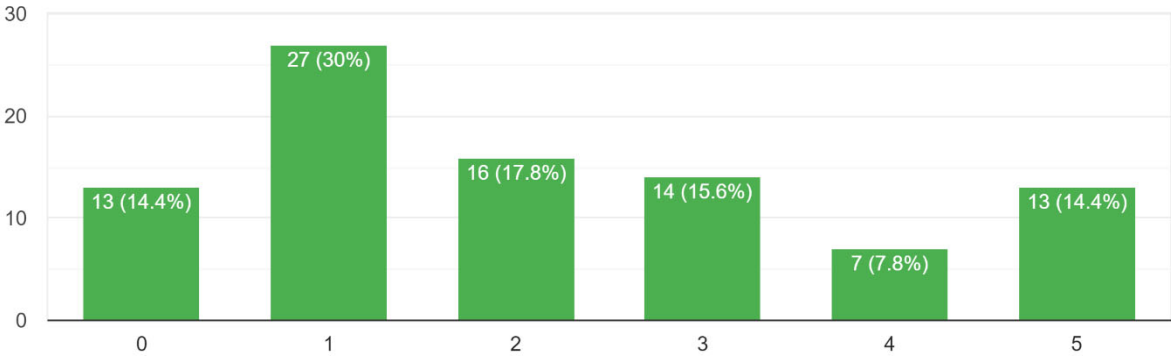
Quality of drinking water

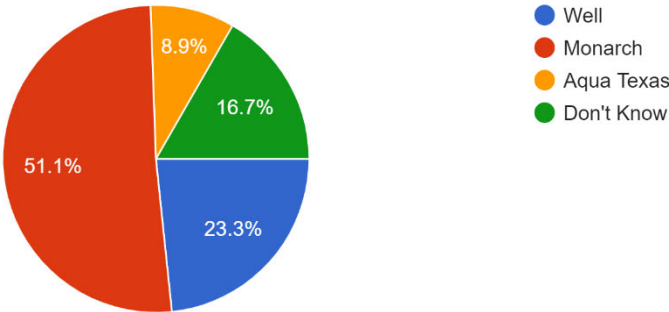
Quality of water pressure

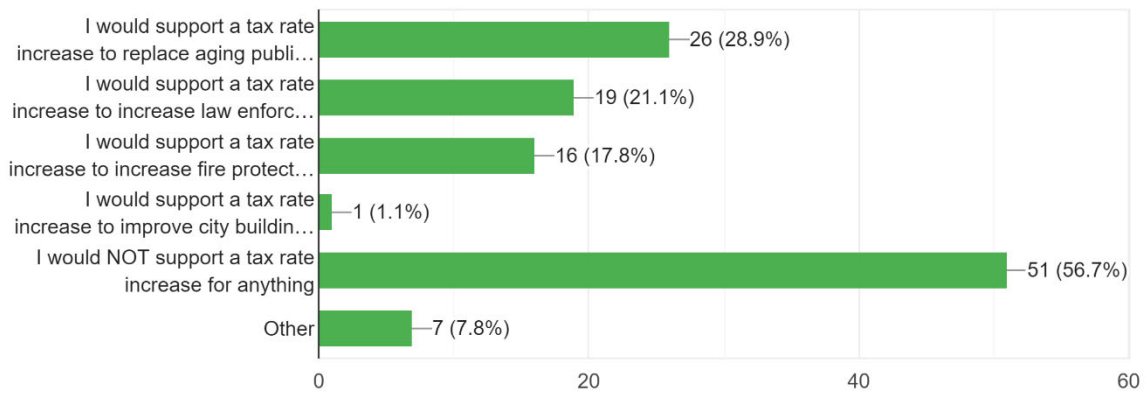
Which of the following are your PRIMARY SOURCES of information about city issues, services, and events? [Check all that apply.]
